
IMPORTS



- 1. The Knife River flint drill was found in Doniphan County.
- 2. The pipestone elbow pipe is from Pawnee Indian Village State Historic Site (14RP1). The pipestone pendant is from Arrowhead Island (14CF343).
- 3. The glass beads and metal hoe are from 14RP1. The French gunflint is from Canville Trading Post (14NO396).
- 4. The Jefferson City Missouri chert scraper is from the Larcom-Haggard site (14CO1).
- 5. The olivella shell bead is from the Radio Lane site (14CO385).
- 6. The Alibates agatized dolomite arrow point is from a site in Rice County (14RC410).
- 7. The obsidian arrow point is from El Cuartelejo (14SC1). This obsidian originated in the Valle Grande Rhyolite of New Mexico. The Southwestern pottery and the turquoise bead are from a site in Rice County (14RC410).
- 8. The obsidian dart point is from the Paint Creek site (14MP1).
